**RESOLUTION FOR SCHOOL TAXES**

**August 21, 2012**

**WHEREAS**, currently school taxes are required to be paid in one lump sum; and

**WHEREAS**, many property owners have difficulty paying school taxes in one lump sum; and

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Legislature recently amended section 1326-a of the Real Property Tax Law to permit the payment of school taxes in three installments when a school district passes a resolution adopting installment payments; and

**WHEREAS**, Board of Education wishes to extend the option of installment payments of school taxes to the residents of the School District.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,**

1. That the Board of Education authorizes the District's tax collector to accept partial payments of school taxes during the warrant period, subject to the following terms and conditions:
  - A. An initial payment in any amount must be paid during the penalty free period for collection by the District.
  - B. Provided the initial installment has been timely paid, a second payment in any amount may be made no later than the end of the collection process by the District, and shall include all applicable statutory interest and penalties.
  - C. Provided that the first two installments are timely paid, a third payment in the amount of the remaining taxes due, including all applicable statutory interest and penalties, shall be made no later than the end of the collecting period by the District.
  - D. No more than three partial payments may be accepted for any given tax year.
  - E. Partial payments may be made only for current-year taxes.
  - F. No partial payments may be accepted from a property owner if there are delinquent real property taxes, special ad valorem levies, or special assessments owed for previous years on the parcel.
  - G. Upon the expiration of the collection warrant period, all unpaid school taxes shall be re-levied onto the subsequent county/town tax bill.

TAX WARRANT  
(Collector Appointed to Serve on a Salary Basis)

Motion made by Mr. Repak Seconded by Mr. Edelby

WHEREAS: Chapter 73 of the Laws of 1977, amended Section 1318, subdivision 1 of the Real Property Tax Law; and

WHEREAS: the entire fund balance at the close of the last fiscal year must be applied in determining the amount of the school tax levy except for an amount not to exceed 4.0% of the current school year budget; and

WHEREAS: this latter amount may be held as surplus funds during the current school year; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Board of Education retain as surplus funds \$1,738,468 from the total fund balance of \$2,478,308 thereby applying \$739,840 to the reduction of the tax levy.

BE IT ADDITIONALL Y RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

To the collector of Fabius-Pompey Central School District No. 1 Towns of Fabius, LaFayette, Pompey in Onondaga County, Cazenovia in Madison County, and Cuyler in Cortland County in New York State.

You are hereby commanded:

1. To give notice and start collection on September 4, 2012 (In accordance with the provisions of section 1322 of the Real Property Tax Law)
2. To give notice that tax collection will end on November 2, 2012.
3. To collect taxes in the total sum of \$7,896,686 in the same manner that collectors are authorized to collect town and county taxes in accordance with the provisions of section 1318 of the Real Property Tax Law.
4. To make no changes or alterations in the tax warrant or the attached tax rolls but shall return the same to the Board of Education. The Board of Education may recall its warrant and tax roll for correction of errors or omissions in accordance with the provisions of Section 1316 of the Real Property Tax Law.
5. To forward by mail to each owner of real property listed on the tax rolls, within ten (10) days after the start of collection, a statement of taxes due on his/her property on press-numbered tax bill forms provided by the school district in accordance with the provisions of Section 922 of the Real Property Tax Law. To forward by mail, without interest penalties, to the office of the County Treasurer a detailed tax bill of all state land parcels liable for taxes on the school tax rolls in accordance with provisions of section 540 and 544 of the Real Property Tax law.
6. To receive from each of the taxable corporations and natural persons the sums listed on the attached tax rolls without interest penalties when such sums are paid before the end of the first month of the tax collection period. To add two percent (2.00%) interest penalties to all taxes collected during the second month of the tax collection and to add three percent (3.00%) interest penalties to all taxes collected during any part of the third month of the tax collection period and to account for such sums as income due to the school district.

7. To issue press-numbered receipts only on forms provided by the school district in acknowledgement of receipt of payments of taxes and to retain, preserve, and file exact copies of all such receipts issued as required by Section 987 of the real Property Tax Law.
8. To promptly return the warrant at its expiration and if any taxes on the attached tax rolls shall be unpaid at that time, deliver an accounting thereof on forms showing by the town the total assessed valuation, tax rate, total tax levy, and total amounts remaining uncollected as required by Section 1330 of the Real Property Tax Law.

The warrant is issued pursuant to sections 910, 912 and 914 of the Real Property Tax Law and is delivered in accordance with Sections 1306 and 1318 of this Law. It is effective immediately after it is properly signed by a majority of the Board of Education. The warrant shall expire on the date stated above unless a renewal or extension has been endorsed on the face of this warrant in writing in accordance with section 1318, sub-division 2 of the Real Property Tax Law.
