2020-2021 Budget Vote, Transportation Proposition Vote
and Board of Education Member Election

Fabius-Pompey Central School District held the 2020-2021 Budget Vote, Transportation Proposition Vote and Board Member Election by absentee paper ballot, mailed to the Fabius-Pompey Central School District, on June 9, 2020. Votes were accepted by mail until and counted on June 16, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. at the Fabius-Pompey Middle School-High School in Fabius, New York on the following:

Proposition I: SHALL THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED?

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Fabius-Pompey Central School District, County of Onondaga, State of New York, be and hereby is authorized to expend during the fiscal year 2020-2021 the sum of \$19,630,414, as set forth in its statement of estimated expenses and to levy the necessary taxes thereof.

Proposition II: SHALL THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED?

Shall the Board of Education be authorized to purchase three (3) 60-passenger school buses, including, for each, related furnishings and equipment incidental thereto at a total estimated cost not to exceed \$350,259, expend therefore a total sum not to exceed \$350,259 which is estimated to be the total maximum cost thereof, and pay for such buses by the levy of a tax which is hereby voted and approved in the amount of \$350,259 which shall be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education and in anticipation of the collection of such tax, bonds and notes of the District are hereby authorized to be issued at one time, or from time to time, in the principal amount not to exceed \$350,259, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said obligations when due.
