BUDGET VOTE AND ANNUAL ELECTION

BUS REFERENDUM

BOARD OF EDUCATION

F-P MIDDLE SCHOOL-HIGH SCHOOL - FABIUS

A vote of the Fabius-Pompey Central School District took place on Tuesday, May 20, 2014, for the purpose of voting from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. in the Fabius-Pompey Middle School-High School Auditorium Foyer and the Pompey Community Church on the following:

Proposition #1

SHALL THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED?

RESOLVED, That the Board of Education of the Fabius-Pompey Central School District, County of Onondaga, State of New York, be and hereby is authorized to expend during the fiscal year 2014-2015 the sum of \$17,230,885, as set forth in its statement of estimated expenses and to levy the necessary taxes thereof.

Proposition # II

SHALL THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED?

Shall the Board of Education be authorized to purchase one (1) 66-passenger bus and two (2) 29-passenger buses, including related furnishings and equipment incidental thereto, expend therefore a total sum not to exceed \$220,000 and pay for such buses by the levy of a tax in the amount of \$220,000 which shall be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education and in anticipation of the collection of such tax, bonds and notes of the District are authorized to be issued at one time, or from time to time, in the principal amount not to exceed \$220,000, and a tax is voted to pay the interest on said obligations when due.

And

Vote for two (2) Board of Education Candidates
