A vote of the Fabius-Pompey Central School District took place on Tuesday, May 21, 2013, for the purpose of voting from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. in the Fabius-Pompey Middle School-High School Auditorium Foyer and the Pompey Community Church on the following:

**Proposition #1**

**SHALL THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED?**

**RESOLVED**, That the Board of Education of the Fabius-Pompey Central School District, County of Onondaga, State of New York, be and hereby is authorized to expend during the fiscal year 2013-2014 the sum of sixteen million, eight hundred eighty-three thousand, two hundred eleven dollars (\$16,883,211), as set forth in its statement of estimated expenses and to levy the necessary taxes thereof.

**Proposition # II**

**SHALL THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED?**

Shall the Board of Education be authorized to purchase two (2) school buses, including related furnishings, equipment, machinery incidental to such acquisitions, and all other necessary cost incidental to such acquisition, and to expend therefore a total sum not to exceed \$210,000 issue obligations therefore in an amount not to exceed \$210,000 and levy a tax for such project.

And

**Vote for two (2) Board of Education Candidates**

The polls were declared open at 7 a.m. by Sue Doupe, Inspector, at the Fabius-Pompey Middle School-High School Auditorium Foyer, and by Alma Hartnett, Inspector, at the Pompey Community Church, and voting commenced.
