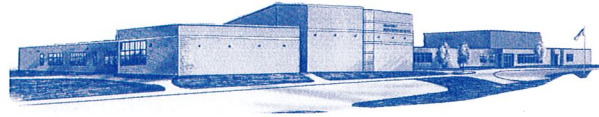

Dear Parents/Guardians/Faculty/Staff:

The Fabius-Pompey Central School District has once again been notified that a student in the Middle School-High School has tested positive for COVID-19. Contact tracing was conducted by the Onondaga County Health Department. The contact tracing indicated that 36 students, spread throughout the Middle School-High School, 7 teachers, 1 bus driver and 1 substitute teacher are to be quarantined.

This latest set of circumstances requires that the Middle School-High School remain in remote learning until November 30. If there is a silver lining, it is that the students will miss fewer in-person instructional days due to the Thanksgiving holiday.


