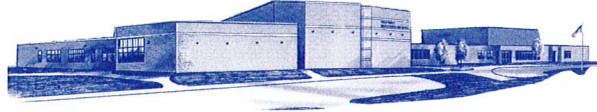

Dear Parents/Guardians:

This past weekend Onondaga County School Superintendents worked closely with the County Executive's Office and with the County Health Department. The goal was, and now continues to be, to have a coordinated effort and a collective response to the coronavirus outbreak. This morning, new information became available, which required some significant changes as set forth by the County Executive's office. The information below is how these changes impact Fabius-Pompey:

- Beginning at the end of the school day, Monday, March 16, and continuing through the end of the day on Monday, April 13, Fabius-Pompey will be closed.
- During this time (March 16 through April 13) there will be no extracurricular activities. There will also be no community use of the school buildings.
- The Tuesday, April 14, 2020 reopening date may be extended by the County Executive if necessary.
- The change in the closure date that had previously been announced came about as a result of an executive order as a result of a confirmed Covid-19 case in Onondaga County.

While school is closed we will continue to provide educational services for our students. We will also continue to provide breakfast and lunch for students who qualify for free and reduced meals, and any other students whose parents wish to purchase a school breakfast and/or lunch. We will use our transportation department to deliver educational materials and meals to students.

Information was sent out in an effort to coordinate these efforts. If you did not receive the email, please contact either the Elementary School office at (315) 683-5857 or the Middle School-High School office at (315)683-5811.

Please note the following information:

- There are no late buses on Monday, March 16.
- Spring sports are scheduled to begin on April 14 (if schools are back in session).
- Unless otherwise directed by local health authorities, school personnel will be allowed to be on campus while schools are closed. Non-school personnel will not be permitted on campus during this time.

As we work through this difficult situation, I will continue to use SchoolMessenger, Peachjar and the District website to provide regular updates to the Fabius-Pompey community. As a school district we will continue to do everything we can to support our students and families.
