# FROM DANIEL S. SILKY ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT OF BUSINESS SERVICES

In the 2022-23 New York State budget, adopted last April, an unexpected and seemingly last moment requirement was added by legislators: all school buses purchased beginning in 2027 must be zero-emission buses. What's more, all school districts' entire bus fleet must be zero-emission by 2035. Zero-emission is synonymous with electric.

This is an enormous change and undertaking for not only school districts, but also bus manufacturers, bus dealers, electric companies, and various other organizations. Currently, a 66-passenger electric bus and charging station range in cost from approximately \$400,000 to \$450,000. (For comparison, a 66-passenger diesel bus costs approximately \$150,000.) Without grants, manufacturer rebates and pilot programs, electric buses are financially out of reach for nearly every school district across the state.

Anticipating the shift to electric buses across the country, the federal government included in the Inflation Reduction Act a total of \$5 billion in funding over five years for clean school bus transportation. The initial round of funding targeted both low income school districts and rural school districts. Through the bus dealer, Leonard Bus Sales, the District applied for funding under the qualifications as a rural school district. Five bus runs, in total, were assessed for funding. The federal program agreed – in August 2022, the District was awarded \$1,975,000 in grants (\$375,000 per school bus and \$20,000 per charging station). The District is not obligated to accept the grant funding. Nor is the District obligated to accept grant funding for all five buses.

Over the past six months, the District has worked with its bus dealer and consultants, architects and National Grid to determine if five buses can be safely supported by National Grid and the existing bus garage. Ultimately, National Grid determined that the existing transformer outside the bus garage cannot support five buses during peak usage. Instead, the District has decided to propose purchasing one electric bus, which the transformer will support and bus garage can accommodate with minimal electrical wiring and logistical changes.

In summary, the taxpayers will make the decision, on the May ballot, if the District should purchase an electric bus for a total of \$42,417 after grants. If approved, the District anticipates the bus arriving no earlier than spring 2024.


**ELEMENTARY SCHOOL NEWS** by Mrs. Goodfellow, Elementary Teacher

On Friday, March 3, six students from Fabius-Pompey's junior class, accompanied by Ms. McNerney and Mr. Wilcox, attended a Student-Athlete Leadership Conference in Cooperstown, New York, where they learned about how to better support, encourage, and lead their teams to success.
