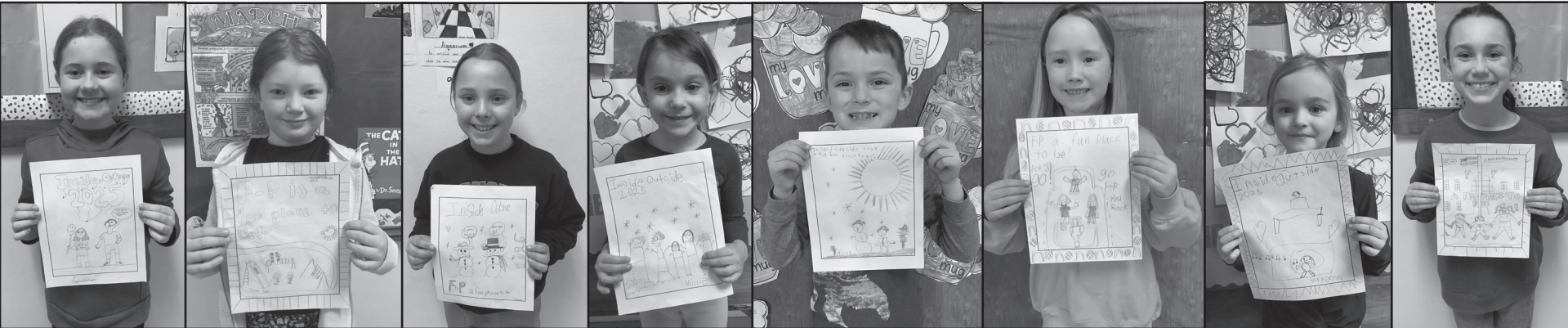
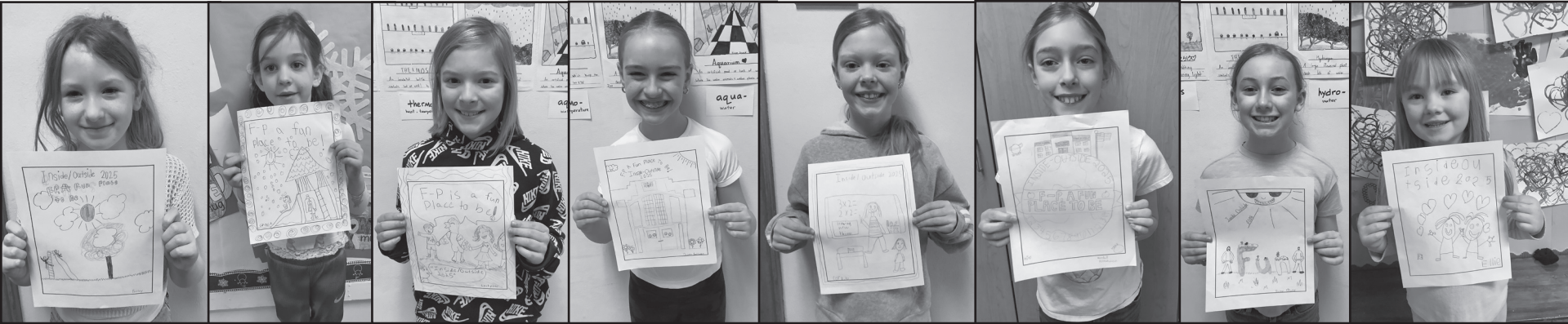

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that petitions nominating candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education shall be filed with the Clerk of the Board at the District Office, not later than 5 p.m. on Monday, April 21, 2025. Vacancies on the Board of Education are not considered separate, specific offices; candidates run at-large. The following vacancies are to be filled on the Board of Education.

Each petition must be directed to the Clerk of the Board, must be signed by at least twenty-five (25) qualified voters of the District, must state the name and residence of each signer, and must state the name and residence of the candidate. Blank petition forms may be obtained from the District Office between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, excepting holidays.

## FROM THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

Over the past few months, the Board of Education has dedicated significant time to developing next year's budget while also projecting financial needs for the next five years. Ensuring the long-term financial stability of our district has required making difficult decisions regarding current and future staffing levels. To keep the community informed, we have been sharing updates as decisions are finalized. With a projected budget shortfall of \$1.325 million, the financial situation remains serious. Additional presentations will be made at upcoming Board meetings, in regular budget mailings, and during the official budget hearing on Tuesday, May 6.

Despite the challenges posed by the current budget situation, our commitment to providing the highest quality education for our students remains unwavering. Over the past year, we have launched several new initiatives while continuing to build upon previously established educational opportunities, ensuring that our students receive the best possible learning experiences.

The district continues to advance its commitment to high-quality education through the implementation of new curricula and innovative programs. In grades 3-5, *Wit & Wisdom* has been introduced for English Language Arts (ELA), while *Eureka*<sup>2</sup> has been adopted for mathematics in PreK-5. At a recent Board of Education meeting, teachers shared preliminary data demonstrating the success of both programs. Plans are now in place to extend *Wit & Wisdom* to PreK-2, ensuring a more cohesive and aligned curriculum both vertically and horizontally. This strategic approach will better prepare students as they transition to middle and high school.

The Board of Education has also been actively discussing the district's strategic plan, which serves as a roadmap for long-term educational success. This plan establishes a clear vision, defines district goals, and outlines strategies for improving student achievement while guiding decision-making and resource allocation. Work on the strategic plan remains ongoing, with a public presentation scheduled for a June board meeting.

The district's commitment to STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art/Agriculture, and Mathematics) education continues to expand at all grade levels. The elementary STEAM lab is actively utilized by fourth and fifth-grade teams, as well as the LEGO League. At the secondary level, a Business and Finance Career and Technical Education (CTE) program has been successfully implemented, and an Agricultural CTE program was recently approved by the New York State Education Department. Robotics, coding, and digital citizenship are integral components of the *Computer Science 8* curriculum, ensuring that students are equipped with essential 21<sup>st</sup>-century skills. Additionally, students participating in the LAN Tech program gain valuable hands-on experience by repairing school computers, reducing district costs while fostering technical expertise.

The district also operates a competitive *Esports* program, which competes against schools nationwide. While Esports is rooted in gaming, it has significant real-world applications across multiple industries, including commercial technology sectors and military careers. The skills developed in Esports, such as teamwork, strategic thinking, and technological proficiency, prepare students for a rapidly evolving workforce.

Despite ongoing budget challenges, the district remains steadfast in its mission to provide students with enriching academic experiences and innovative learning opportunities. Through these continued efforts, we ensure that our students are well-prepared for future academic and professional success.

As the community is aware, we are facing significant budget challenges. However, our district continues to move forward with several exciting initiatives that enhance student learning and opportunities. The Board of Education remains dedicated to maintaining a high-quality education while balancing fiscal responsibility. Our focus remains on supporting students, staff, and the broader community as we navigate these challenges and work toward long-term success.

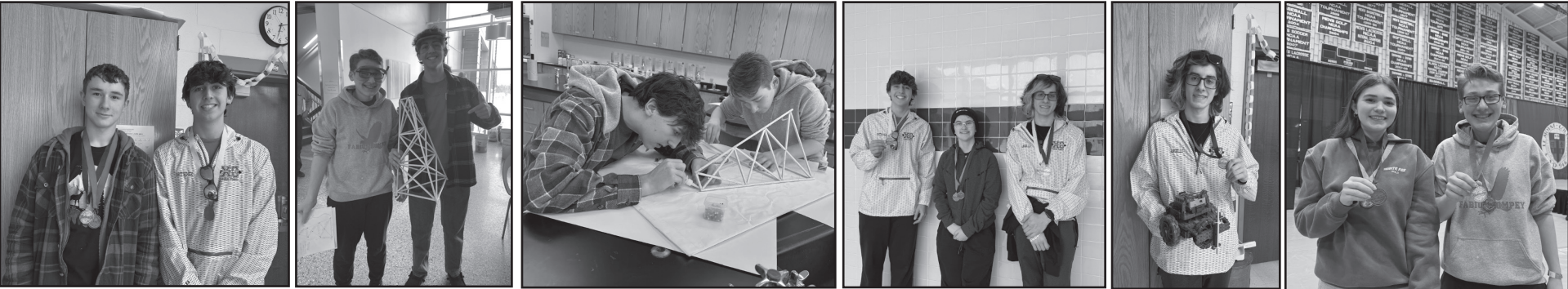
HIGH SCHOOL SCIENCE OLYMPIAD NEWS

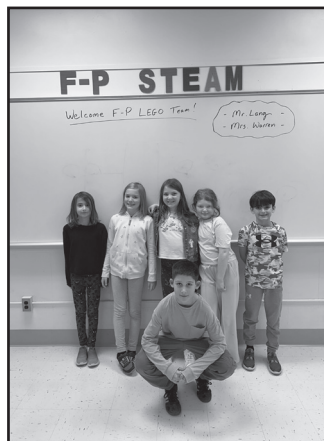
## STEAM ACADEMY NEWS

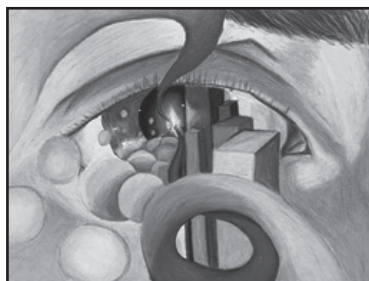

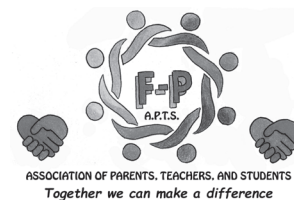
