FROM THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

At the March 6 Board meeting, several letters of interest were reviewed from individuals interested in filling the vacated school board position. The BOE selected Gina Myers and wished her well and much success in serving the community on the F-P School Board.

We will be finalizing next year's budget during the next couple of meetings. The annual budget hearing will be held on May 7 with the budget vote and board member election held on Tuesday, May 21. Those interested in running for the school board will have until April 22 to submit the required nominating petition. More information on the budget and board member election will be provided in upcoming newsletters.

The BOE policy subcommittee is finishing its review and update of the district policy manual. The BOE and District would like to thank members of the policy subcommittee - Denise DiRienzo, Eric Exelby, Holly Frazee, Jean Gasparini, William Gumpfer, William Neumire, Joe Peck, Dan Silky and Karen Wilcox - for the time and energy they have put into this two-year long process. You can find the policy manual posted on the F-P website.

Over the years, one of the BOE overall objectives has been to go beyond providing our students with a basic education. In doing this, we have worked to be proactive rather than reactive. This has been demonstrated by our district being recognized in the top 10% of public high schools nationwide. We offer a wide assortment of honors and AP classes and have jumped into the 21st century by providing one-on-one learning devices. We are currently working on developing a curriculum that will be PreK-12 aligned. This will provide a seamless transition from grade to grade, elementary to middle school, and middle to high school. As we continue looking forward to meeting the needs of our students and providing a direction for our schools, a purposeful plan is needed. A strategic plan. We have enlisted the help of our local BOCES instructional support division to help us develop this strategic plan. It will be a process where they will guide us in evaluating the present and help to organize, anticipate, and plan for the future. In essence, a roadmap to follow for where we need to go. It will be a living document that we can change as needed to meet our future needs. This will be a massive undertaking that will require a substantial amount of time, energy, and commitment from all stakeholders. This includes our students and staff, the administration, parents, and the community at large. The plan will be multifaceted with strategy development and an implementation process that can be continually adjusted as we move forward. Please join us in this process by completing the surveys, which will be forthcoming, and getting involved. It takes all of us to make and keep F-P great. Stay tuned and watch for more information as we work on the development of the strategic plan. We look forward to your support and participation in this process during the next year as we develop this living document to guide us into and through the future.

SOLAR ECLIPSE ON APRIL 8, 2024

The solar eclipse of 2024 is soon to be upon us! Solar eclipses occur somewhere on Earth about every two years, but they are often in far flung places away from populated areas. The eclipse on April 8 is unusual because it will cross over millions of people in Mexico, the US and Canada. After this eclipse, we'll have to wait until 2044 to see the next solar eclipse in the US. Eclipses occur when the new moon, which is normally unseen, perfectly lines up to block the sun as seen from a narrow path on Earth. Total solar eclipses are a sight to behold. Only then can the wispy corona of the sun be seen without special instruments. Because the path is narrow, it's important to know when it is safe to look at the sun without special filters.

This eclipse will be about 98.7% total in the F-P district. This will cause the sun to be considerably dimmer than normal, but this is very important:

At no time during the eclipse will the sun be safe to look at from anywhere in the Fabius-Pompey district, without the use of special filters! These filters must be used at all times!

Approved solar filters are being handed out to all F-P students. These are safe for solar viewing (whether there is an eclipse or not). Please inspect the filters to be sure there are no scratches. If you see scratches in the filters, they should be discarded. Looking directly at the sun when the eclipse is not total is very dangerous. Intense visible light, as well as UV and infrared radiation can create a permanent scar on the retina. Please be sure your children are not removing the filters, even when the sun becomes very dim. The maximum dimming of the sun will occur at 3:23 p.m. in the F-P district. Again, the eclipse will not reach totality within the F-P district.

On the other hand, if you have the opportunity to go just a bit north of our district, you can observe the total solar eclipse. When the eclipse is total, the filters are not needed during that brief event. In Syracuse, there will be 1.5 to 2 minutes of 'totality'. Further north, along Lake Ontario, there will be over 3 minutes of totality.

While this sounds very brief, the differences between totality and 'almost' total are profound.

The longest totality a solar eclipse can be is about 8 minutes. In 2017, I drove to South Carolina to see 2 minutes and 32 seconds

of totality. Despite huge traffic jams, I still think it was worth it! During totality, planets and stars were suddenly visible - birds started to roost and insects began their night songs - it got cooler. It looks kind of like a sunset in the middle of the sky - not totally dark, but very mysterious.

Of course, the main issue with every solar eclipse is the weather. Even a single cloud can disrupt your view. I use the National Weather Service satellite images to determine if clouds will be in the way. Don't rely only on where it is raining or snowing. You need to look for cloud cover. If you are mobile and clouds are in the way, the best bet is to drive southwest or northeast, since our prevailing winds are from the southwest.

To recap - the eclipse will not be total anywhere in the F-P district. Filters must be used at all times.

If you can get to the path of totality, filters are not needed, but only during the brief time of totality. At all other times, the filters must be used.

A few frequently asked questions:

Are phone cameras safe to use in a solar eclipse?
Yes, phone cameras have built-in filters that prevent damage to the phone. Also, looking at the phone display is not dangerous, though it is better to use 'selfie view' so you can look at the sun 'over your shoulder.' through the phone. If you try to photograph the sun in the same direction you are facing, it is easier to accidentally look at the sun.

It should be noted that photographs of the sun, even when it is almost completely eclipsed, are generally of very poor quality. The sun looks tiny, is often blurry, and even a tiny amount of direct sunshine distorts the image.

Are there other ways to view the eclipse that do not involve using the filters?
Yes! The easiest and safest way to view a solar eclipse is by creating a 'pinhole camera.' Instructions to create a pinhole camera are easily found online. Most people use a piece of thin cardboard or cardstock. Even kitchen strainers may be used to create dozens of images of the eclipse as it progresses.

In conclusion, if you take necessary precautions for the solar eclipse on April 8, you can safely enjoy this unusual natural event!


Beaver Lake Elementary Art Show!




