

Important Information regarding medication use at school:

For both prescription and over-the-counter (OTC)

Medications prescribed during school hours:

- Authorization/Order forms are valid for one year.
- Signatures are required from the Health care provider AND Parent/Guardian.
- Medication must remain in the properly labeled pharmacy container or the original OTC container.
- The parent/guardian is responsible to have the medication delivered, directly to the school, by an adult.

- If your child is in the MS/HS and has rescue medications for respiratory conditions, epinephrine device, or insulin, glucagon, and diabetes related supplies:
 - They may be allowed to self-carry/self-administer their medications.
 - They would need their health care provider to indicate “self carry” on their medication order form.
 - Also, a self medication release form needs to be signed by the Health Care Provider AND the Parent/Guardian.

Medication authorization forms are available on our district web site, may be obtained from the school health office or your physician may use their own form.

Medication orders may be mailed or faxed to your Health Office.
