2022-2023 Budget Vote, Transportation Proposition,
and Board of Education Member Election

A vote was held by the Fabius-Pompey Central School District on May 17, 2022, from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Fabius-Pompey Middle School-High School in Fabius, New York and at the Pompey Community Church in Pompey, New York on the following:

Proposition I: SHALL THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED?

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Fabius-Pompey Central School District, County of Onondaga, State of New York, be and hereby is authorized to expend during the fiscal year 2022-2023 the sum of \$20,035,232, as set forth in its statement of estimated expenses and to levy the necessary taxes thereof.

Proposition II: SHALL THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION BE ADOPTED?

Shall the Board of Education of the Fabius-Pompey Central School District be authorized to purchase and finance three replacement student transportation vehicles, including necessary furnishings, fixtures and equipment and all other costs incidental thereto, and expend a total sum not to exceed \$360,000, which is estimated to be the total maximum cost thereof, and said amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of said School District and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law; and, in anticipation of such tax, obligations of said School District, in the principal amount not to exceed \$360,000, shall be issued.
