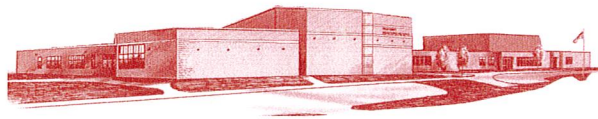

Dear Parents/Guardians:

As you know, as Omicron continues to make its presence felt, Onondaga County is reaching higher levels of COVID positive cases than ever before. As a result, new mandates have been issued by the Department of Health (DOH).

In terms of contact tracing for close contact of COVID-positive individuals, on January 14 DOH stated that, "Schools may work with their local health department to ensure that members of the school community, including students, staff and teachers, who test positive for, develop symptoms of or are exposed to COVID-19 have access to the information they need to take appropriate steps to protect themselves and others. This may include isolating or quarantining, notifying close contacts, staying home when ill, monitoring symptoms, and wearing a well-fitting mask. Isolation and quarantine attestation forms, and related information are available at state and local health department websites." All pertinent DOH information on the updated Isolation and Quarantine guidelines can be found at <https://coronavirus.health.ny.gov/new-york-state-contact-tracing#top>.

In response to this new guidance the Onondaga County Health Department has implemented an attestation form in which individuals self-report their positive COVID-19 test result and take it upon themselves to inform their close contacts. The form is available at <https://covid19.ongov.net/at-home-covid-test-results-screen/>.

In light of the state and county moving away from contact tracing during the recent COVID virus surge, individuals who are COVID positive should inform the school district of their test results. The District will continue to record this data on the New York State Department of Health website.
